Rings & Surface: Trial will be held in 2 rings (95 X 90) inside on packed dirt. Rings will both run simultaneously. All obstacles used are according to NADAC rules.

** This will be a "containerized" trial **

Classes Offered:

Saturday: Regular 1, Regular 2, Jumpers, Chances, Touch N Go, Numbered Hoopers

Sunday: Regular 1, Regular 2, Jumpers, Chances, Weavers, Tunnelers

Trial is limited to 350 runs per judge per day for classes with jumps and up to 500 runs total per judge per day

Details:

- Costs per dog per run:** For all dogs in the same household, entries received and paid for in the same transaction.
Runs added at a later date start @ the \$12.00 level
1 to 5 runs=\$12.00 6 to 14 runs=\$ 11.00 15 to 28 runs=\$10.50 29+ runs=\$10.00
- Refunds:**
- ◆ There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, including, but not limited to, aggressive dogs.
 - ◆ Handlers with medical emergencies providing a doctor's note or having an injured dog or bitch in heat, with veterinarian's documentation, may cancel 24 hours prior to the start of the trial and receive a 50% credit slip.
 - ◆ Due to the rising costs of trial production there will be no refunds after closing and a \$10 processing fee for cash refund before closing though an exhibitor may choose to receive a credit slip for 100% of the refund value for no additional cost.
- Move-ups:**
- ◆ **Saturday Move-ups** must be received in writing (email acceptable) by the trial secretary no later than **Monday March 19th by noon** to allow enough time to finish pre-trial processing.
 - ◆ Sunday Move-Ups will be allowed at this trial if received no later than 30 minutes after the last class on Saturday. There will be a Move-up sheet at the score table.
- Set up:** No set up is permitted before 3 pm on Friday March 30th. Argus Ranch personnel will remove items that are left prior to that time.
- Start Time:** Judges' briefing begins each morning at approximately 7:30 am. First dog on the start line at 8 am.
- Warm-up Area:** A warm up area consisting of a regulation jump and a set of weave poles will be available to all exhibitors. The warm up obstacles may not be taken in sequences.
- Awards:**
- ◆ Ribbons will be awarded for first thru fourth place in all jump heights of all divisions except for Chances which is a Q/no Q class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs.
 - ◆ **Please let us know if you may achieve a NATCH or Medal so that we have a ribbon for you too.**
- Levels, Classes, Divisions, Categories:**
- ◆ **Levels** are Novice, Open and Elite, a dog may be in different levels throughout the trial.
 - ◆ **Classes** are Regular, Jumpers, Chances, etc.
 - ◆ **Divisions** are Standard, Veteran (Handler or Dog), Junior Handler (JH); a dog may not be entered in more than one division of the same class at a trial but may be in different divisions in different classes if handled by different people, i.e.: Standard Regular, JH Jumpers, or Veteran Handler Weavers.
 - ◆ **Categories** are Proficient or Skilled, a dog is in one category for the duration of the trial. Skilled dogs MUST jump 4" lower than their Proficient height. Visit www.NADAC.com for further details
- Measuring:**
- ◆ All dogs entered at 8", 12" or 16" for Proficient (except for 16" Jr. handler/Vet. Dogs) are required to be measured by a judge before competing if a height card is not presented at check in or submitted with the entry form.
 - ◆ Dogs measuring into a higher jump height on the day of the trial will be moved up to the correct height immediately.
 - ◆ Dogs measuring into a lower jump height will not be adjusted the day of the trial.
 - ◆ **Skilled dogs do not need to be measured.**

FROM NORTH/SOUTH I-5 OR SR-167

- Exit **HIWAY 18 EAST**
- Exit **AUBURN-BLACK DIAMOND ROAD EAST**
keep right
- **RIGHT** at **SE GREEN VALLEY RD** (just past Neely Mansion)
- Follow Green Valley Rd **APPROXIMATELY 7.5 MILES**
- **RIGHT** onto **212th Way SE** (Christmas tree farm on the left)
- First **LEFT** into Argus Ranch driveway Follow signs for parking

FROM SR-196 SOUTHBOUND

- **RIGHT** onto **ROBERTS DR** (in front of coal car)
- Follow Roberts Dr **APPROXIMATELY 4 MILES**
- **LEFT** at **218TH ST**
- Bottom of the hill is **STOP SIGN**
- **STRAIGHT ACROSS OVER CEMENT BRIDGE**
- First **LEFT** into Argus Ranch driveway Follow signs for parking

FROM SR-196 NORTHBOUND

- **LEFT** at **SE GREEN VALLEY RD** (Boondocks Nursery)
- Follow Green Valley Rd **APPROXIMATELY 4 MILES**
- **LEFT** at **212TH WAY SE**
- First **LEFT** into Argus Ranch driveway Follow signs for parking



Notice to Exhibitors:

- ◆ This trial is sanctioned by the North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC) with Zooming Agility Pups (ZAP) as host club. Exhibitors through a submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- ◆ **Dogs must be registered with NADAC and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.**
- ◆ Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- ◆ Any dog demonstrating aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside of the ring, must be excused for the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- ◆ No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course entrance at any time. The only exception is leading your dog to the start on lead, and then handing the lead to a steward.
- ◆ Current Jump Height Tables, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook.
- ◆ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog or handler is disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- ◆ Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the email address on the official entry form before the closing date and again one week before the trial. A paper confirmation letter will be sent to those without email. **If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary, Katrina Tustin, at Info@AllDogsOnline.com.**
- ◆ Zooming Agility Pups, All Dogs Training Services and/or NADAC are not responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or possession of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause.
- ◆ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ◆ **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$40 fee for any returned checks.**
- ◆ No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of Zooming Agility Pups.
- ◆ ZAP may refuse any entry for reasons other than those expressly provided by NADAC Rule and Regulations. Anyone not in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed at this trial.
- ◆ **It is a requirement of the club and the facility that dogs be on leash at all times except in designated off-leash areas. Owners must clean up after their dogs or they may be barred from further trials.**
- ◆ Illegal use of drugs and/or alcohol on trial grounds is strictly forbidden.
- ◆ **Only crates, not x-pens, are allowed inside the arena in designated areas. A single row of chairs ringside will be permitted.**

IMPORTANT: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC. **Levels.** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.
